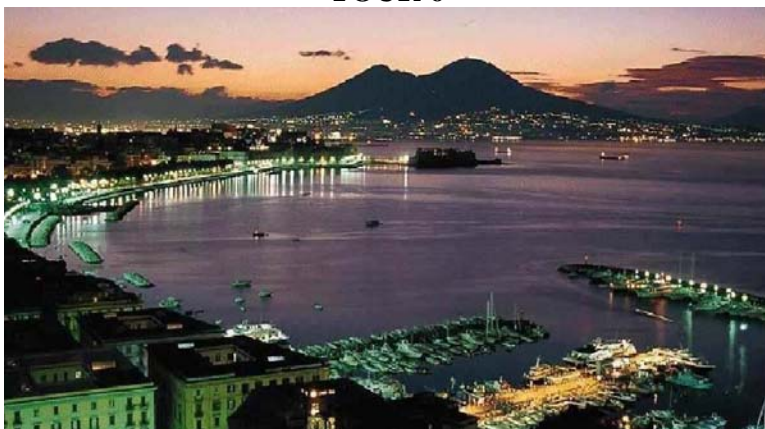

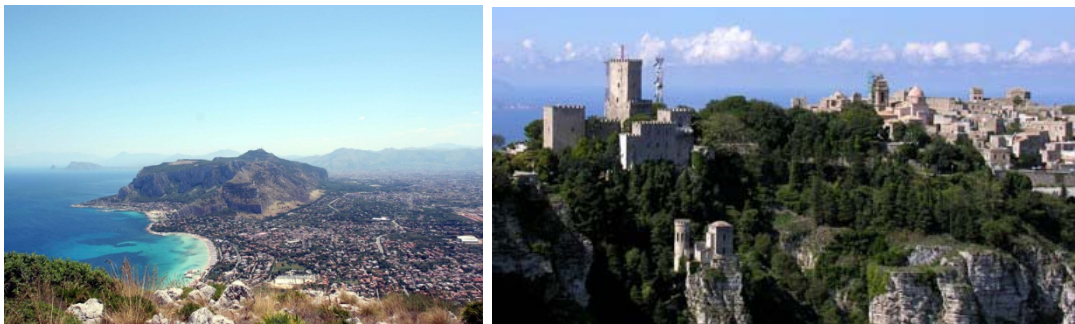

### Day 1

#### MILAN – STRESA – LUGANO – COMO

Departure at 8.30 a.m. from MILAN by a deluxe coach to the LAKE MAGGIORE.

**LAKE MAGGIORE:** one of the largest Italian Lakes. Departure to STRESA.

**STRESA:** Arrival in STRESA, an international tourist resort situated in a central but also panoramic and picturesque position along the lakeside roadway, stands just in front of the Borromee islands.

Tour of the Pescatori island by boat: the island, is named after the main activity which over the centuries has characterized this fishermen town. Although only few families still go on with the original activity, the identity of the small community appears still intact. Tourists are fascinated by its simple houses, the narrow lanes, the stone portals and the attractive underpasses.
